<p><b>Plastic</b> Bottles and containers with a neck that had a screw-on cap.</p> 	<p>Any aluminum or steel food cans that have contained paint, chemicals or other non-food materials</p>
	<p>Containers that have held fertilizer, pesticide, or other chemicals Motor oil or other automotive fluid bottles Whipped topping containers Cottage cheese containers Deli containers Glad type containers Margarine tubs Rubbermaid and Tupperware type containers Yogurt containers Juice and yogurt bottles</p>
